





Karren Cable Car

Get away from all – by day and night

Anyone wishing to fly high is right at Karren. This cable car brings its visitors to a height of 976 meters in less than 5 minutes. From there, you can enjoy an incredible view of the Rhein valley, the Swiss mountains, and Lake Constance. On the „Karren-Kante“ balcony, which is 12 m long and was constructed in 2016, visitors can feel nature up close and personal, virtually standing on thin air. The panorama restaurant holds true to its promise of good food, and you can enjoy a good meal and the view at the same time. Furthermore, Karren is a starting point for numerous hikes.

Rappenloch & Alploch Gorge


Natural jewels in Dornbirn

In winter the gorges are closed for your own safety. The visit is free.

Immerse yourself in four levels and over 700m² of beer tradition and the brewing trade at the Mohren Museum and Beer Experience. The crown jewel of the exhibition is the historic brewing equipment of Sattein's Schäfle inn brewery. It dates to the 19th century and was in operation until 1917. This facility was restored for the museum with affectionate detail work. Numerous exhibits – from the collection of the Huber owner family – along with interactive and multimedia display technology make the past easy to understand. We will take you along for a captivating beer experience from Thursday to Sunday.

inatura is a unique museum concept that interactively introduces visitors to exciting topics, and makes research, science, and technology “understandable”. Visitors can have fun learning about specific topics in many experiments with study objects, films, and pictures. A restaurant, playground, city garden, and proximity to the inner city’s pedestrian zone will make your trip to inatura an excellent experience.

Nature Jewel Ebnet

A unique playground can be found lying in the middle of a lovely mountain landscape only 20 minutes from the center of the city.

The outdoor specialists from the Ebnet experience have many activities in the programme. Offerings range from a high rope course to a gorge fox obstacle course, a 3D archery course, canyoning, horseback riding on Icelandic horses to educational nature modules or forest tours. School classes, families, clubs, departments of numerous companies and international guests can join the teambuilding events in Ebnet. Registration required.

Dornbirn Nativity Scene Museum

The Dornbirn Nativity Scene Museum is located in a renovated horse barn, over 100 years old, at the beginning of the Rappenloch gorge. Roughly 120 nativity scenes and nativity scene figure groups from nearly all over the world are exhibited. The highlight of the exhibition is the new 16m² and up to 2.50 m-high passion nativity scene from famous nativity scene builder Antonio Pigozzi from Italy.


Enz Forest Bath


Game Factory Indoor Playground



Fun Facts about Dornbirn



Many surnames in Dornbirn initially originated from the names of their professions: Gerber (tanner), Hämmerle (small hammer), Maurer (mason), Schmied (blacksmith), Schmitter (reaper), Schneider (tailor), Zimmermann (carpenter) etc.

Ebnit formerly belonged to the imperial county of Hohenems and became a separate municipality in 1806, which was merged with the municipality of Dornbirn in 1932.

The redwoodtree in Gütle has a height of 41 meters and a diameter of 1.55 meters. It's age has been estimated at approximately 90 years.

Since 2013 Dornbirn has been twinned with Dubuque in the United States. During the first wave of emigration, this city in Iowa was the first port of call for more than 200 Dornbirners.

The two-screen movie house Cinema 2000 shows films in their original language with subtitles.

A colourful bunch. People from 116 countries live here in Austria's tenth largest city.

In the year 1881 the Gasthaus Gütle entered the history books: Emperor Franz Josef I put into operation the first telephone connection in Austria-Hungary between the Gütle spinning mill and the trading counter at the company F.M. Hämmerle. Even today there is still a 'Kaiserzimmer' in this traditional inn.

Back in the day Dornbirn's mayors were elected directly on the marketplace – a huge spectacle – today the city's farmers market is held here twice a week.
