inatura is a unique museum concept which guides visitors through exciting topics in an interactive way and allows them to really "grasp" research, biology and technology. In experiments with objects of study, films and images, visitors are taken on a playful journey through the mountain, forest and water habitats which are typical of Vorarlberg. The human body is another area of focus. You can wander through the organ systems and use all your senses to find out how these work and the optimal way these are supplied. There are also special exhibitions, tours, various events and a restaurant.

Kunstraum

The Kunstraum Dornbirn exhibition centre was established in 1987 as a not-for-profit association with the aim of presenting and teaching contemporary art. Since 2003, the historic assembly hall of the former Rüscherwerke machine plant in Dornbirn's city gardens has offered the perfect conditions for presenting extensive, room-filling installations. The quality of the architecture in its original, raw condition leaves room for current trends in the international production of art. With a maximum of four exhibitions per year, the works of established, internationally renowned artists are shown alongside those of newer artists.

Flatz Museum

The FLATZ Museum in the former premises of the Alte Naturschau dates back to a donation of artworks by the artist FLATZ, born in Dornbirn in 1952, to the city of Dornbirn. This was opened in 2009 by the former documenta director Jan Hoet. The FLATZ Museum is seen as a forum of discussion about contemporary artistic impulses and positions. The museum is a place where the artistic position of FLATZ is presented and taught. It features changing exhibitions created by international guest curators with a focus on photography, reading events, lecture series, discussions and performances. The collection includes some of the artist's key works from the period 1975 to 1999 and also features loaned works from private collectors.
